

How to register on DESICO. Registration and KYC

If you haven't already, you will be requested to register on DESICO —the process will include a Know-Your-Customer and Anti-Money Laundering (KYC/AML) procedure as a legal requirement. If you already registered, you will be able to login using your email and password and continue your purchase without re-doing the registration procedure again.

Here are the important things you need to know before participating in the sale:

- Please have your international passport or government-issued ID card ready—a driver's license, student ID, or any other form of ID than a passport or government issued ID will not be accepted.
- Please make sure you are using a device with a good quality camera and you are in a well-lit environment—laptop and desktop computers with webcams or mobile devices are supported as long as the camera takes high-quality pictures.
- You will need to fill in a short appropriateness questionnaire under MiFID Markets in Financial Instruments Directive) that will take a couple of minutes to finish. This is a legal requirement. This is not a test, and there are no right or wrong answers.

STEP 1—REGISTER FOR SECURITY TOKEN OFFERING BY PASSING KYC

The first step you need to take is to create your account. If you have already registered, login with your email and password and skip to STEP 2.

STAY SAFE: Create a strong password you do not use anywhere else. Do not disclose your password to anyone. Team members will never ask you for your password, or offer you tokens at a discounted rate. Please report to us via email hello@desico.io.

After creating your account, we will ask you to answer a few mandatory questions we are required to ask by the regulator.

KYC

Identify yourself following the instructions on the screen. Make sure you are in a well-lit room or any other place with plenty of light. The image quality is crucial for the success of the KYC procedure. As practice shows, 99 percent of KYC procedures fail due to poor face and/or document image quality.

You will see a display of your face on the screen. The system will want to make three pictures:

1. Your face;
2. Front side of your ID;
3. Back side of your ID.

P.S If you choose to use your passport, you will also be asked to take a picture of the cover of the passport too.
